Dear Parents & Guardians-

In Aviation History & Literature (AHL), students are required to complete the Aviation Choice Project which will stand as a test grade. Students have three options to complete this project: read a book, view a film, or interview a pilot. Specific guidelines and requirements follow each of the choices, and books and films must be selected off of the list provided by Mrs. VanZegeren.

The project seeks to expose students to the many facets and eras of aviation over time. The element of choice is offered so that students may choose an avenue to explore an aviation topic in depth that is of interest to them. The due date for this project is **SEE WEEK IN PREVIEW**. This gives students approximately 5 weeks to complete the project requirements. The project is worth **75 points**.

This project asks for support at home as students are responsible for securing a time and place to read their book, view a film, or conduct an interview. Copies of each of the approved book titles are available, but limited. They will be checked out to students on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you'd like to watch a film, the student is responsible for locating a copy of the movie. Please note that none of the films have a higher rating than PG-13, but film choices are left to the discretion of each individual parent or guardian.

A parent/guardian signature is required to ensure that parents/guardians are aware and supporting their student at home in completing this project.
